FIRSTCHOICE TRANSFER CHECKLIST

Ready for a change? Please see the below guide for what to expect when you are requesting a transfer to, from, or within FirstChoice:



M CORE COLLEAGUES FIRSTCHOICE (NATIONAL OR REGIONAL)
Refer to site specific local transfer policies to determine eligibility to transfer. Discuss transfer with current manager.
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Apply for position on Workday (as an internal candidate). Be prepared to provide an updated resume and current certifications, upon request.
FirstChoice TAP (recruiter) will reach out to you within 1-2 business days of submitting application.
You will be required to complete and pass Relias testing prior to advancing in the interview process.
Within 1-2 business days of passing Relias testing, TAP will reach out to schedule an interview with the
FirstChoice Program Manager (PM).
Interview with the Program Manager (PM).
PM to complete Interview Feedback form, which may take up to 7-10 business days.
Once TAP receives the Interview Feedback form, TAP will contact you with transfer decision.

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Ш	Once all steps are complete, you will be notified of clearance and receive your new Long Term Assignment (LTA) documents.

	If transfer is not approved , either the Regional or National PM will reach out to discuss with you. If transfer is approved , the National PM will send the TAP (recruiter) the required documentation for transfer and below next step will be completed: TAP will reach out within 1-2 business days, and you will be instructed to: Complete application (as internal candidate, in Workday). Complete Transfer Offer in Workday. TAC (Onboarding) to review and request Employee Health records from Local RHM/ record validation – you may be asked to complete additional onboarding steps, if warranted.

	Discuss transfer with current FirstChoice Program Manager (PM). Apply for position (as an internal candidate, in Workday). Be prepared to provide an updated resume and current certifications upon request. Local RHM TA will receive and screen your application to ensure requirements/guidelines are met. If you pass the screening process, the Local RHM TA will schedule an interview for you with the local RHM hiring manager. If transfer is approved, a transfer date will be agreed upon and your transfer will be initiated.

Important Information:

- TAP will discuss Payroll Schedules with your Program Manager. Transfers cannot occur in the middle of a pay cycle. Your transfer date with occur the Sunday of the new pay period.
- Colleagues are held at the same experience qualifications to transfer to and within FirstChoice (see TAP for more information).
- When transferring from core to FirstChoice, colleagues cannot return to the same unit with an LTA for 6 months to 1 year, depending on the state. You are allowed to work per diem in your previous unit if you are floating to other units/hospitals, but not an LTA.
