Trinity Health Team Virtual Rounding Tool Use Beyond COVID-19 Patient Care

At Trinity Health, the health and safety of our patients and colleagues remains our top priority. During the COVID-19 pandemic our virtual rounding tools have allowed providers to round on patients while limiting potential exposure to the virus. Beyond COVID-19, Trinity Health's virtual rounding tool will continue to supplement the quality care you deliver by providing an alternative to in person rounding.

Virtual Rounding enables providers to establish a remote video visit with patients and is available for any patient interaction where a hands-on physical exam is not necessary.


Consider Virtual Rounding for:

- Isolation (COVID-19, patients under investigation for COVID-19, Tuberculosis, Influenza, etc.)
- Protected rapid response/code scenario.
- Virtual rounding is integrated into modified workflows to enable visibility and telephony for rapid response team members who remain outside of the room
- Remote psychiatry evaluations of patients in isolation or of patients at facilities remote from the workspace of the psychiatry staff
- Inpatient follow up visits or "second rounding" to convey test results, status updates, or review plans.
- Consultations by providers outside of the facility, enabling providers who rarely come to the hospital to render their initial opinion remotely.
- For example, plastic surgery consults performed with the assistance of a local clinical resource to interact with the patient, presenting the wound exam to the remote specialist for immediate examination and guidance of therapy.
- Nursery visitation for parents unable to visit their newborns in the NICU in person
- Parents may visualize and speak to their baby via virtual rounding.



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- Skilled Nursing Facility visits by providers outside of the LTC facility
- Colleagues providing medical interpretation services may join a provider-patient visit from remote locations, facilitating improved communication
- Enable Medical Students to join the rounding in isolation rooms without entering the room

Benefits of Virtual Rounding

- Conserves PPE
- Facilitates rapid specialist evaluation when on-site specialists are immediately available
- Empowers more efficient follow up visits
- Allows on-screen information sharing with patient
- Enables a portion of the team to remain outside the room in situations of increased risk
- Provides opportunity for patient to interact with family members who may be unable to visit
