

Child Care Provider Matching Assistance

Carebridge, our Employee Assistance Partner (EAP), has <u>enhanced its resources</u> to help colleagues more efficiently find child care providers who meet their budget and other requirements. The new resources include:

- A virtual child care locator tool, which provides listing of state-licensed child care facilities within a colleaguedetermined local area. Create a personal login on MyLifeResource.com using the code "BKKR5."
- One-to-one phone consultation. Child Care Specialists are available to help colleagues and their families
 find child care provider options in their community. They will note the family's specific priorities and work
 them to find the solutions to meet their needs and budget. They will also provide education about child care
 safety and liability considerations.
