Complete required COVID-19 prevention education course by May 31

All Trinity Health colleagues are required to complete a new course for COVID-19 prevention education. You will be assigned the "SARS-CoV-2 Preparedness, Notification and Response Plan" course in HealthStream before Feb. 15. SARS-CoV-2 is the scientific name for the virus that causes COVID-19. **All Health Ministry colleagues are required to complete the course before 11:59 p.m. ET on Monday, May 31, 2021.** System Office colleagues have an earlier completion deadline of March 1, 2021.

The course was developed to meet Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) and other regulatory requirements related to our COVID-19 prevention efforts. After taking the course, you should be able to:

- Identify non-clinical aspects of SARS-CoV-2, and how we can help prevent the spread of COVID-19
- Identify general infection prevention practices
- Distinguish the differences between PPE and face coverings
- Identify how to report work-related exposures and unsafe work conditions
